

Your 2017-18 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) requires additional information in order to verify that you are either a citizen or national of the United States, a permanent resident of the United States, or an eligible noncitizen of the United States. You may provide proof of your eligible citizenship or immigration status in one of two options: (1) presenting original documents for photocopy and validation in person directly through the Office of Financial Aid, or (2) utilizing a Notary Public Official to certify the presentation and photocopy of your original documents. You may not mail, scan, or fax copies of your original documents or a valid unexpired government-issued photo identification without this signed affidavit and use of a Notary Public Official.

OPTION 1: In-Person Presentation of Original Citizenship/Eligible Noncitizenship Documents
(to be signed at the institution)

The student must appear in person at the University of Indianapolis to provide proof of U.S. citizenship or eligible noncitizenship status directly to a school official in the Office of Financial Aid. The school also will request to see a valid unexpired government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport.

- **Acceptable original documents for Proof of U.S. Citizenship:** Original birth certificate, Passport (current or expired), State Department documents (i.e., FS-240, FS-545, DS-1350), Naturalization Certificate, or Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561).
- **Acceptable original documents for Proof of Eligible Noncitizenship:** Alien Registration Receipt Card (I551), proof of permanent residency status, or evidence from the Immigration and Naturalization Service that you are in the United States for other than a temporary purpose with the intention of becoming a citizen or permanent resident.

OPTION 2: In-Person Presentation of Original Citizenship/Eligible Noncitizenship Documents to a Notary

If the student is unable to appear in person at the **University of Indianapolis** to provide proof of U.S. citizenship or eligible noncitizenship status, the student must present original documents to a Notary Public Official, along with a copy of a valid unexpired government-issued photo identification card (ID) bearing his/her portrait (or likeness).

- **Acceptable original documents for Proof of U.S. Citizenship:** Original birth certificate, Passport (current or expired), State Department documents (i.e., FS-240, FS-545, DS-1350), Naturalization Certificate, or Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561).
- **Acceptable original documents for Proof of Eligible Noncitizenship:** Alien Registration Receipt Card (I551), proof of permanent residency status, or evidence from the Immigration and Naturalization Service that you are in the United States for other than a temporary purpose with the intention of becoming a citizen or permanent resident.
- **Valid unexpired government-issued photo ID:** A driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport.
