

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDING GUIDELINES 2021-2022

HIGHEST MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

Students are awarded the highest merit scholarship for which they are eligible based on the academic criteria established for each scholarship fund. This award takes precedence over all UIndy awards of lesser value. However, talent awards (art, music, theatre and speech, etc.), the United Methodist Award and the Legacy Award may be added to the merit scholarship as long as the overall maximum for all gift aid is not exceeded.

MAXIMUM SEMESTERS

UIndy merit scholarships may be received for up to eight semesters (six semesters for Transfer Scholarships) of full-time **undergraduate** study provided renewal requirements are met.

MAXIMUM FOR ALL GIFT AWARDS

The UIndy merit scholarship in combination with other gift aid such as UIndy talent awards (art, music, theatre, speech, etc.) or scholarships may not exceed the cost of university assessed charges for tuition and a standard book allowance for commuter students or tuition, standard double and triple occupancy room (not to include increased charges for certain residence halls such as Central, Roberts, East), 14 meal plan and a standard book allowance for students living in on campus housing. Students who live on campus and have outside scholarships may receive a combination of gift aid to include increased charges assessed for some residence halls.

MAXIMUM UINDY GIFT ASSISTANCE FOR GREYHOUND VILLAGE, THE LOFTS, AND COLLEGE CROSSING

Any combination of gift aid including all scholarships, grants, merit awards, talent awards (e.g. art, music, theatre, speech, etc.), tuition waivers and any other UIndy gift assistance may not exceed the cost of university assessed charges for tuition, standard double occupancy room, and a standard book allowance when residing in Greyhound Village, The Lofts, and College Crossing.



AWARD AMOUNT RESTRICTIONS

UIndy merit scholarships cannot be used to cover tuition costs at another institution (e.g. study abroad, etc.), overload credit hours, internships that assess charges for participation, course fees, music fees, special fees or tuition for summer enrollment periods.

MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS

All merit aid awarded for undergraduate study is not available for graduate study in any program. This includes students who enter into the first year of an early entry graduate program after only three years of undergraduate study, or students who graduate with a BS degree in three years.

ATHLETIC GRANTS

Several additional NCAA and UIndy policies apply to students receiving Athletic Grants. If minimum academic thresholds for class rank, gpa and test scores are achieved, Athletic Grants may be combined with UIndy merit scholarships. Athletic Grants in combination with all other gift aid may not exceed the cost of tuition for a commuter student or tuition, room and board for a student living in an on-campus residence hall. Athletic Grant may not be used to pay the charge for a single room including East Hall (which are all single rooms), Greyhound Village Apartments (all single rooms), The Lofts, and College Crossing.
