Clinical and Counseling Studies Concentration (12 hours)

- **PSY 250** Personality Theories (3)
- **PSY 345** Abnormal Psychology (3)
- **PSY 395** Readings in Clinical Psychology (3) (*Prerequisites: PSY 124, 125, 345*)
- **PSY 425** Fndtnl Skills of the Helping Professions (3) (*Prerequisites: PSY 120 or 124, 345*)

NOTES:

- This concentration is available to any student who meets the eligibility requirements for the courses listed in the concentration; however, courses completed in order to earn the CCST may not be counted toward a major or minor in Psychology
- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the CCST
