Minor

A Chemistry minor is appropriate support for majors in a number of areas, but is most commonly associated with majors in Biology, Computer Science, Environmental Science, Mathematics, Physics, or Business.

Chemistry Minor requirements:

- **CHEM 150** General Chemistry I** (3) **and CHEM 151** General Chemistry Lab I** (1)
 - **CHEM 160** General Chemistry II** (3) **and CHEM 161** General Chemistry Lab II** (1)
 - **CHEM 250** Organic Chemistry I** (3) **and CHEM 251** Organic Chemistry Lab I** (2)
 - **CHEM 310** Analytical Chemistry** (5)
 - **CHEM** Chemistry Electives (230 level or above) ** (2)
- (Some electives require prerequisites not listed above. Consult the catalog before scheduling.)

** Requires a grade of C or above

NOTE: A grade of C (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Chemistry Minor.
