- A grade of C (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Illustration Major.
- The Illustration major requires a minimum of 60 hours of Art courses.

- The Bachelor of Art or Science Degree requires a minimum of 120 hours.
- Art & Design majors must take ART 105 Foundation: Freshman Seminar in Art & Design as their New Student Experience (NSE) course.

- A student may complete more than one major as long as each major has at least 24 discrete hours. Please see the Academic Catalog for additional details.
- **Modern Language (8 credits) for B.S. in the Shaheen College of Arts & Sciences**
 - FREN, GERM, or SPAN 101 and 102 (or higher)
 - Students must demonstrate competency through the 102-level of a modern foreign language. This may be done by achieving the recommended score on the placement exam (201) or by completing courses through 102 or above with a passing grade.
- **Modern Language (8 credits) for B.A. in the Shaheen College of Arts & Sciences**
 - FREN, GERM, or SPAN 201 (or higher)
 - Students must demonstrate competency through the 201-level of a modern foreign language. This may be done by achieving the recommended score on the placement exam (300) or by completing courses through 201 or above with a passing grade.
