**Applied International Relations:** Minimum 2 hours from the following:

- **IREL 300** Model United Nations (1)
- **IREL 302** Model European Union (1)
- **IREL 450** Internship in International Relations (1-15)

**Foreign Language:** 4 hours of a modern language beyond the Bachelor of Arts requirements, or evidence of fluency or native ability in one language other than English.

**NOTES:**

- The International Relations Major requires a total of 41 credit hours. No more than 4 hours of internship credit may apply to the International Relations major.
- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the International Relations Major.
- The Bachelor of Arts Degree requires a minimum of 120 hours.

- A student may complete more than one major as long as each major has at least 24 discrete hours. Please see the Academic Catalog for additional details.
