## Minor

**Required Courses: 8 credits**

- SPAN 201 Spanish Language and Culture III (4) (or placement equivalent)

**Electives: Choose 12 credits from**

- LANG 480 Selected Cross-Cultural Topics (3)
- SPAN 204 Intermediate Spanish (4) (or equivalent)
- SPAN 317 Spanish Culture & Civilization (4)
- ST 299 Spring Term Travel (3)

Minor = SPAN 102 and 201 plus 12 credits from the above classes.

\* The 4 hours of SPAN 101 do **NOT** count toward the Latin American Studies minor.

**NOTES:**

- The Latin American Studies minor requires a minimum of 12 hours plus SPAN 102 and 201, excluding the 4 hours of SPAN 101.
- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Latin American Studies Minor.
- The Bachelor of Arts Degree requires a minimum of 120 hours.
