New Student Experience (3 credits)

- **SCAS 101** Return to Learning (3) (Must be taken the first semester enrolled in Adult Learning Programs, concurrent with COMP 150)

Computer Literacy (3 credits)

- **COMP 150** Microcomputer Applications (3) (Must be taken the first semester enrolled in ALP, concurrent with SCAS 101)

Capstone Requirement (3 credits)

- **SCAS 410** Excellence in Liberal Studies (3) (very last course taken before graduation)

Notes

1. All students enrolled in the Adult Learning Program are required to take SCAS 101 and COMP 150 concurrently in their first semester.
2. The Bachelor of Liberal Studies requires a minimum of 120 credit hours, 3 hours for the capstone included.
3. Students must take 44 – 48 hours in general education core classes as part of this major.
4. At least 30 hours must be from upper-level courses (300 level and above), including the capstone course.
5. All remaining hours will be completed as electives.
