- 4. ORGL 410 also meets the Capstone requirement in the General Education Core.
- 5. The Bachelor of Science in Organizational Leadership requires a minimum of 120 credit hours.
- 6. Adult Accelerated Programs students must satisfy the General Education Core requirements with exceptions. SCAS 101 fulfills the FYS and NSE requirement. Lecture/Performance and Spring Term are not required.
- 7. A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Organizational Leadership Major, including the General Education Core courses.
- 8. Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher in all accelerated courses to remain in good standing in the accelerated program.
- 9. Students are responsible for knowing and fulfilling the requirements for course prerequisites for graduation. These requirements are listed in the Academic Catalog.
