Required Courses (12 credits):

- **PHIL 101** Introduction to Philosophy (3) **OR**
- **PHIL 130** Honors Philosophy (3)
- **PHIL 110** Critical Thinking (3)
- **PHIL 201** Introduction to Ethics (3)
- **PHIL 301** Ancient and Medieval Philosophy (3) **OR**
- **PHIL 302** Modern Philosophy (3)
- **PHIL ELEC** Two (2) philosophy elective courses (6)

Total Hours for PHIL Minor: **18 credits**

NOTES:

- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the PHIL Minor.
- Students may substitute an appropriate FYS PHIL/ETHICS course for PHIL 101 or PHIL 201 upon approval of the Philosophy & Religion Department.
