Minor

**Required Courses (18 credits):**

- **PSY 120** Introduction to Psychology (3) **OR**
- **PSY 124** Foundations of Psychological Science I – Methods (3)
- **PSY ELEC** Five psychology courses (15) \*

(Must be three credit hour courses with at least one at the 300 or 400 level)

**NOTES**

- Additional information about the courses listed above can be found in the section entitled Course Descriptions.
- The clinical and counseling studies concentration is not available to psychology minors.
- \*The following courses may not be used to fill the requirements for the Psychology Minor: PSY 165 Careers and Educational Pathways for Psychology Majors, PSY 400 Writing and Professional Development in Psychology, and PSY 476 Capstone in Psychological Sciences
- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Psychology Minor.
- The Psychology Minor requires a minimum total of 18 credits.
- Psychology minors may elect to take PSY 120 or PSY 124 as a PSY elective (whichever course they did not complete for the minor requirement).
- This program may require attendance in both day and extended programs classes.
